SUBJECT: Skill Identifier (SI) 2 Application – CPT Stewart, Jocelyn C.

1. I have reviewed Captain Stewart's application for designation as SI 2, Senior Military Justice Practitioner, and find that, with the exception of the Graduate Course and three Criminal Law elective credits required for SI 2, Senior Military Justice Practitioner, the quality of her experience and application merit award of SI 3, Expert Military Justice Practitioner.


